\*Future Business Leader is the test only. While there will be RSC winners, that does not preclude any Oregon FBLA member from participating in this event at SBLC. At SBLC, only the top 30 based on interview materials and test score will advance to the first round of interviews.

\*\*Most all events that start with “Introduction” are open only to 9-10 grade members. One Introduction event is a Middle Level event. None of these events are open to members in grades 11-12.

\*\*\*Only the test score will count in determining the top 10 places. The top 10 teams/individuals will have the opportunity to practice with a role play at RSC.

\*\*\*\*Events marked **Middle Level** are only available to registered Middle Level members. These events are not SBLC qualifiers.

### **SBLC Qualification**

The events listed on the table above are qualifiers for SBLC competition. Students must place in the top 10 at RSC to compete at SBLC in that event. There are more than 20 events that are “state only” and are not offered at RSC. Chapters will have two wild card entries that they will be able to note during registration. Each RSC will report its winners to the state office. SBLC event registrations will be cross checked against the RSC winners’ lists.
