## Oregon Champion Chapter

*This event is designed to recognize chapters that have provided their members the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities that promote the goals of FBLA-PBL.*

**NOTE: The activities have been adjusted so that activities that are in the national Champion Chapter Program are not duplicated with the Oregon FBLA version of the program. ### Eligibility

1. Each local chapter may enter this event, and each chapter must be on record in the FBLA-PBL National Center as paying dues by March 1 of the current school year.
2. Chapters that complete Champion Chapters will be considered for the Gold Seal Chapter Award of Merit.
3. To be eligible for this award, a chapter must accumulate a minimum number of points on the Oregon FBLA-PBL Champion Chapters form.
  - **Gold Chapter Awards:** Chapters will be recognized as a Gold Chapter if they obtain at least 600 points on the Oregon FBLA-PBL Champion Chapters form.
  - **Silver Chapter Awards:** Chapters will be recognized as a Silver Chapter if they obtain at least 500 points on the Oregon FBLA-PBL Champion Chapters form.
  - **Bronze Chapter Awards:** Chapters will be recognized as a Bronze Chapter if they obtain at least 400 points on the Oregon FBLA-PBL Champion Chapters form.
  - **Honor Roll:** Chapters will be recognized as an Honor Roll Chapter if they obtain at least 300 points on the Oregon FBLA-PBL Champion Chapters form.

### Awards

The number of awards presented at the State Business Leadership Conference will be determined by the number of entries received with validated ratings. Chapters recognized in the Champion Chapters program who also submitted the Local Chapter Annual Business Report will be considered for the national Hollis and Kitty Guy Gold Seal Chapter Award of Merit.

### Recognition

Honor Roll – Ribbon at SBLC, state website recognition

Bronze – Ribbon at SBLC, state website recognition, certificate in conference packet

Silver – Ribbon at SBLC, state website recognition, plaque at SBLC

Gold – Ribbon at SBLC, state website recognition, plaque and banner at SBLC

### Regulations

1. The all documents must be submitted via [Champion Chapter Portal](#) by 5:00pm on March 1<sup>st</sup>. (If your chapter is not listed in the portal dropdown, contact [hello@oregonfbla.org](mailto:hello@oregonfbla.org))
2. All supporting documentation files should be labeled Chaptername\_#\_A and in the file format listed. If no format is listed, then PDF is the required format. Example: Augustus\_8\_A.pdf
3. All supporting documentation must be provided based on the information in this guide.
4. All documentation will be reviewed and scrutinized and points will not be awarded if documentation is inaccurate, insufficient, or incomplete.
