The inaugural eXpo was held in April 2022. Due to the coronavirus, this was the first in-person state conference since 2019; furthermore, it was the first time our members had united in one place for three years. In a time dictated by the uncertainty of the future, we hoped this event would help attendees with something they could prepare for: their future. Deciding what career path to pursue is an immense, stressful task, especially with the knowledge that every passing day brings us closer to a future we may not feel prepared for. 

Event Information

The eXpo will be held on April 7 at the DoubleTree by Hilton at 1000 NE Multnomah Street in Portland, Oregon. The eXpo will run from 10-3pm, with setup from 8-10am. All exhibitors will be gone by 4pm. Upon arrival, exhibitors will be provided with one parking pass for the hotel parking garage. During setup, a coffee and pastry bar will also be available. Box lunches will be distributed in the afternoon. It is a priority of

ours that exhibitors are full of food and energy!

The event will take place inside the hotel's exhibit hall, the entrance of which may be seen in the photo to the right. The layout of the room will look similar to the layout below:





Please note that while the overall layout depicted above will remain the same, the specific number of tables and their exact location may differ. Regardless of location, every booth will be visible and accessible to all attendees. Attendees will enter at the main entrance at the triangle, where they will be greeted by Oregon FBLA State Officers at the purple table. Following the direction of the arrows, they will be able to visit every booth before exiting where they came in.

Attendees will walk through six categories of exhibitors, each represented by a different colored area in the layout above. Yellow tables represent adviser opportunities; dark blue are reserved for higher education institutions; red are for college groups; turquoise for military branches; green for special interest groups and organizations; and orange for career opportunities.

The location of an exhibitor's booth is determined by the booth selection process associated with the package they purchase. A detailed breakdown of each package may be found below.

- Select booth location immediately after payment
- Can purchase up to 3 additional tables, \$100 each
- Logo is highlighted in eXpo slideshows

- One representative invited to serve as a panelist on our Preparing for College Admissions Workshop
- Representative receives plaque and recognition on stage during opening general session, with complimentary conference reservation
- Donated items distributed to every conference attendee
- Able to request power
- No booth restrictions, aim for the stars!

**Every exhibitor will have access to a coffee and pastry bar, as well as a box lunch. Each organization will receive one free parking pass.

Item Donations

Different packages include different logo distribution opportunities. Based on the package you purchase, your logo can appear on eXpo promotional material that either eXpo attendees or all conference attendees will receive. It can also appear and be highlighted on slideshows that will be shown during the eXpo and general sessions. You will have the opportunity to attach the branding you would like used to the registration form.

As an additional opportunity exhibitors to get their logo in the hands of student leaders from across Oregon, we are asking for donations of drawstring bags, as well as any small items to go inside the bags. These items, including but not limited to pens, lanyards, and chapstick, will serve as mementos of the opportunities available exciting attendees. Only those who purchase the Ultimate package will have opportunity to donate drawstring bags. Those with the Deluxe or Ultimate package may offer smaller items to go in the bags. These drawstring bags will be given on a first come first served basis.

Registration



After paying, you will receive an invoice and a confirmation that payment has been received. You will receive a link for booth selection at the time associated with your selected package, which may be immediately after payment, after the priority deadline, or after the general deadline. This link will only be sent to you once both registration and payment have been finalized. Those with the Basic package will not receive the link, as booth selection for this package is random.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the focus of the eXpo?

The focus of the eXpo is to connect the student leaders and instructors of FBLA to the wide variety of opportunities that surround them. Businesses, colleges, organizations, special interest groups, military branches, and other areas that can benefit and be benefitted by these leaders of the future are invited to help reach this goal.

How many high school and middle school students will be present?

Our members will be coming from across the entire state of Oregon, with most of our chapters coming from the coastal side of the state, mirroring our population. We will have about 300 Middle Schoolers, 200 Freshmen, 400 Sophomores, 600 Juniors, and 450 Seniors.

How many people can be in our booth?

There should be at least one representative within the designated area at all times. This will ensure all eXpo attendees have the opportunity to learn about you! As long as there is one representative at the booth, any number of additional representatives may be present, given they stay within their booth's area, which is defined in the package options above.

Will we need to provide our own setup?

A standard table and generic white table cloth will be provided to each exhibitor. Everything else is yours to provide! We encourage exhibitors to bring any branded materials that make their booth representative of their group. Let us know if you have any specific requests and we can see what we can do!
