Regional Competitive Events

— General Guidelines

Participant Eligibility for Region Level Competition

- *Participants can compete in up to two (2) events at the regional level, with NO LIMITS on performance events*
- *Oregon FBLA will not institute limits to the number of competitors a chapter can register for each competitive event – Chapters can register an unlimited number of members per event*

State Level Qualification / Eligibility

- *Participants can compete in up to two (2) events at the state level. Chapter Events do not count towards the two (2) event limit per participant.*
- *The top 10 winners at the regional level will still be recognized and receive awards.*

Tie Breaking Pedagogy

Ties will be broken in the following order:

1. *Judges Determination*
2. *Online Test Result – the last 10 questions, followed by time*
3. *Pre-Judged Materials*

Competitor Conduct

Any participants found to be sharing event topics, scenarios, or test questions with any other person (including guests, advisers, chaperones, members from other schools) will be disqualified from ALL competitions. Depending on the severity, the participant may be removed from the conference or in certain cases the entire chapter may be disqualified from competition.
